The MARZ Project is a drop-in after school program for youth 13-19 years old at The Ink People Center for the Arts. We provide training in video and music production, writing workshops, digital graphics, and a safe, creative space for youth to hang out. (We do have instruments but music is mostly digital at this point because we've had to temporarily relocate due to earthquake damage to the TIP facility at the Muni.) We also have art supplies for those so inclined. Our Media Crew is engaged in projects and local collaborations and learning professional level skills.
